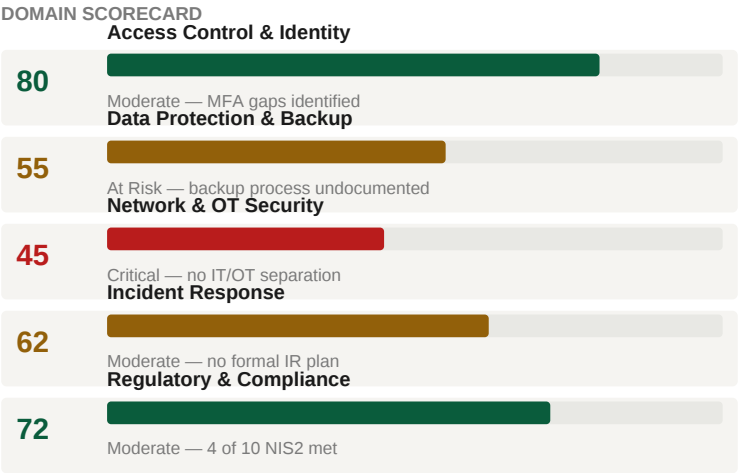
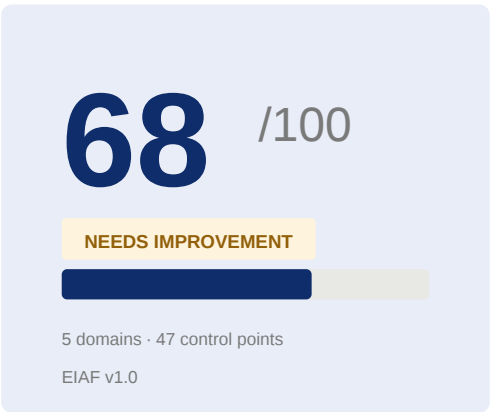

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Cyber Readiness Assessment was conducted for an anonymised industrial maintenance contractor in the Norwegian maritime services sector. The company was evaluated across five security domains comprising 47 individual control points, aligned to NIS2 Article 21 requirements and ISO 27001 controls. The overall Cyber Readiness Score is 68/100, indicating moderate readiness with critical gaps in network security and access control. Four of ten NIS2 Article 21 requirements are currently met. Three priority actions are required before the company can confidently respond to enterprise supplier assessments or satisfy NIS2 registration obligations due in Norway from July 2026.
